

Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo – FAQs

Where is the Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo playing?

ANZ Stadium is located in Sydney Olympic Park, 17kms west of the CBD in the heart of Sydney. For a map of ANZ Stadium and Sydney Olympic Park, please [click here](#).

Where in the Stadium is the concert stage located for the Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo shows?

The castle will be located in the southern end of ANZ Stadium arena. For a diagram of the stage and seating plan, please [click here](#).

What are the show dates and times for the Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo concerts?

The Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo will perform at ANZ Stadium on the following dates and times:

Thursday 17 October at 7.15pm, Friday 18 November at 7.15pm and Saturday 19 October at 10:45am and 7.15pm.

On each day, the Stadium's public gates will open at 5.45pm and 9.30am for the matinee show on Saturday.

IMPORTANT NOTE: TO ENSURE YOU DON'T MISS THE START OF THE SHOW, WE RECOMMEND YOU BE IN YOUR SEAT BY 7:15PM (10:45 FO THE MATINEE).

Performances are scheduled to finish at approximately 10pm and 1.30pm for the Saturday Matinee show.

Where do I enter the Stadium for the Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo concerts?

Each concert ticket provides patron seating and gate entry information. You should check your individual event tickets for your designated entry gate.

How do I get to ANZ Stadium?

All tickets to the Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo concerts include entry and travel on Sydney trains and Metro services to and from the event. Remember to keep your event ticket safe for your return journey home, as you must have a valid ticket when travelling on public transport.

ANZ Stadium strongly recommends public transport as the most time and cost efficient way of getting to and from the concert.

Where do the trains run from?

Thursday 17th and Friday 18th October

- Express services will operate from Central to Sydney Olympic Park station every 30 minutes from 5pm to 12.30am.
- An additional service will leave Epping at 6.13pm, stopping all stations to Olympic Park via Homebush.
- Direct trains between Lidcombe and Olympic Park run every 10 minutes until 12.30am each night.

Saturday 19th October

- Additional service from Central will run every 30 minutes between Central and – Olympic Park from 9am and 3pm, then every 20 minutes between 3.20pm and 12.30am stopping at Strathfield and Redfern.
- Direct trains between Lidcombe and Olympic Park run every 10 minutes until 12.30am.

Where do I catch a bus?

The following Sydney Buses services run to Olympic Park:

- Route 525 runs between Parramatta and Burwood via Sydney Olympic Park.
- Route 526 runs from the Sydney Olympic Park Ferry Wharf to Olympic Park.
- Route 533 runs from Sydney Olympic Park to Chatswood via Rhodes & North Ryde.

Do taxis have access to Sydney Olympic Park?

Yes, although we recommend you use your entitlement to public transport that comes with your Royal Military Edinburgh Tattoo concert ticket. A taxi rank is located on Herb Elliott Avenue near the Pullman Hotel. For a list of taxi companies please visit the [Ministry of Transport](#) website.

What's the best route if I have to drive?

Where can I park my car?

Parking is limited in the Sydney Olympic Park precinct, so to guarantee a parking space we recommend you pre-book parking well in advance of the concert dates. Parking can be purchased from the Sydney Olympic Park Authority by [clicking here](#).

Please note: pre-booked parking tickets cannot be booked on the day of the event. A car park shuttle bus service will operate between the open car parks. Follow directional signs as you enter the park. A drop off and pick area for this service is located close to ANZ Stadium's north eastern entry gates (Gates E and G).

What are the walking distances from the public car parks and transport drop-off points to the Stadium?

Approximate distances to the Stadium's eastern entry gates from public car parks:

P1 = 514 metres
P3 = 762 metres
P4 = 1030 metres

Note: the above distances are measured from each car park's pay station.

The distance to the Stadium's eastern entry gates from the Sydney Olympic Park Rail Station is approximately 340 metres.

I am a patron with accessible needs. What assistance can I get at the Stadium?

The Stadium is a highly accessible venue. However, if you come to the Stadium with an accessibility aid such as a walking frame, you may need to cloak it with our staff in an area close to the location of your seat.

The Stadium staff will do all they can to assist patrons with accessibility needs, but we recommend you get in touch with us if you have any questions about the Stadium, its services, or any special requirements you may have during your visit.

Are tickets still available for purchase?

Yes. Tickets can be pre-purchased from Ticketek on 132 849, online at www.ticketek.com.au through all Ticketek agencies or at the Stadium's ticket box offices on concert day.

What happens if I lose my ticket?

Call Ticketek on 132 869 for information on lost or stolen tickets.

Is it safe to buy tickets from scalpers?

No. You risk wasting your money on a ticket that is liable to be invalid. Re-selling tickets above face value is a breach of the Conditions of Sale.

Ticketek is the ONLY authorised ticketing agent for this event. To ensure you don't end up with invalid tickets, **DO NOT** buy them through any **unauthorised re-sellers** such as Viagogo, Ticketmaster Resale, Tickets, eBay, Gumtree, Tickets Australia, Ticket Merchant, Ticket Blaster, Ticket Bis, Queenoftickets, etc.

ANZ Stadium has no obligation to honor tickets bought from any agent other than Ticketek.

Can parents bring infants or toddlers without a ticket?

No. Every patron entering the Stadium must have a valid ticket.

Can I take an umbrella into the Stadium?

Yes, but please refrain from putting it up in the seating bowl as umbrellas will obstruct the view of other patrons. Make sure you bring a raincoat, spray jacket or poncho if the weather is not looking great.

Can I take an esky or bag into the Stadium?

Yes. As long as the esky or bag is no larger than 35cm in height, 20cm in width and 30cm in length (i.e. your esky or sports bag should not be too large to be stored under a seat).

Can I take binoculars?

Yes.

What else should I bring with me to the concert?

It's recommended that you bring minimal personal items with you to the show. However, given the performance time is approximately two and a half hours, we suggest for your comfort that you bring a small cushion to sit on as the Stadium seating has no padding.

Can I take my mobile phone?

Yes.

Can I take a camera or recording device into the concert?

Yes, cameras and recording devices are permitted for personal images only but not for commercial purposes. Camera tripods are not permitted.

What food and drink can I carry into the concert?

Patrons are permitted to bring small amounts of food and drink (no alcohol) into ANZ Stadium.

As a guide, personal belongings, including food and drink for personal use, should be contained in a small day pack.

The following items are prohibited;

- Glass and cans
- Alcoholic beverages
- Metal cutlery items and other sharp utensils
- Other items deemed to be dangerous

Will my bag be checked?

Yes. Security checks will be carried out on all bags, so to help avoid delays it's best to leave your bag at home if you possibly can.

What can I purchase inside ANZ Stadium?

ANZ Stadium has a variety of retail food and beverage outlets available throughout the Stadium, offering a wide selection of product.

Can I buy official Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo merchandise at the concert?

Merchandise outlets are located throughout ANZ Stadium and in the surrounding precinct. Official Royal Edinburgh Military Tattoo merchandise will be available for sale.

Will there be cash facilities at the venue?

Limited ATMs are available outside the venue and inside the Stadium. Patrons are encouraged to visit an ATM before entering the venue to avoid queues.

Will there be First Aid facilities?

Yes. Medical crews will be present to attend to any problems, no matter how big or small. To allow us to assist you, please let the staff near your seating area know if you have a medical condition that may require treatment during your visit to the Stadium. Please remember that our staff are there to assist you.

Will pass-outs be available?

Pass-outs will not be available once you are inside ANZ Stadium.
